The person will work closely with the Apollo Tyres Foundation and the project Coordinator.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

The position will require close coordination with Project Coordinator and will be providing the support to the Truckers community in the below mentioned areas-

- Vision (near vision, distance, vision, and color blindness)
- Prescription of glass as per Power
- Counsel the beneficiaries for wearing the spectacles
- Maintain records related to vision care
- Cataract Referral and follow up
- Generate monthly report and submit to project coordinator
- Analyze OPD data related to vision and shared to project coordinator
